## *Homeschool Prom 2020*

### Code of Conduct

We have a wonderful evening planned for our homeschool teens at the **Homeschool Prom 2020**! Our theme this year is “*Moonlight Masquerade*”. Before purchasing a ticket to the **Homeschool Prom 2020**, please read the following Code of Conduct. It provides information regarding our expectations of all prom guests, parents/guardians and chaperones who will be joining us for the evening. The purchase of a ticket indicates you have read, understand and agree to the details in the Code of Conduct. If you are purchasing a ticket for a prom guest other than your own, be sure they (and their parent/guardian) have read, understand and agree to the details in the Code of Conduct.

#### **PROM GUESTS**

Prom guests of the **Homeschool Prom 2020** are homeschool teenagers (ages 13 through high school) who are currently enrolled as a middle school or high school student. A prom guest may bring additional people (ex: non-homeschool student) who meet the requirements of a **Homeschool Prom 2020** prom guest. All non-homeschool prom guests must meet the prom guest grade and age requirements, purchase a ticket, adhere to the [Code of Conduct](#), and complete a [Waiver and Release form](#). Tickets to the **Homeschool Prom 2020** are non-refundable. You do not have to be a member of Homeschool Roster or any other homeschool group to attend.

We are all examples for each other, so present yourself well and behave in a manner that represents the best you, always. Prom guests are expected to follow the guidance of all prom chaperones. If you are asked to leave for any reason, you will not be given a ticket refund.

#### **PARENTS/GUARDIANS**

Homeschool parents/guardians may attend the **Homeschool Prom 2020** with the purchase of a ticket. Parents/guardians are defined as a legal guardian and/or a designated person by a legal guardian of a prom guest. An older teen (not currently enrolled as a middle school or high school student) or adult may not attend as a prom guest or date.

## **DRESS CODE**

The **Homeschool Prom 2020** is a formal dance, an evening for prom guests to dress in their finest attire.

**Ladies** may wear a modest formal or semi-formal dress that is not revealing:

- No plunging, revealing or low-cut necklines or back.
- No side or front cut-outs below the natural bra line.

Two-piece dresses may be worn, but must:

- Show no bare midriff and the top must always cover the waistline (ex: when dancing).

Strapless dresses and dresses with spaghetti straps are permitted.

Dress length should:

- Not have a slit or hem higher than three (3) inches above the top of the knee and are not see through at that length.

See through fabric:

- Must meet the three-inch requirement for length and modesty as previously indicated. The see-through portion of a dress should begin after the three (3) inch hem requirement.
- No full bodice or skirts are to be see-through.

All appropriate undergarments should be worn.

Keep modesty in mind: above the waist, not too revealing and below the waist, not too short.

**Gentlemen** may wear a tuxedo or suit, or a dress coat with semi-formal dress pants, and a belt, with a buttoned-up shirt and a tie.

Dress shoes are to be worn. If Converse are worn, they must be in good condition. Athletic shoes, flip flops, Crocs, etc. and non-dressy boots (i.e. cowboy, hiking, military, snow boots, etc.) are not permitted. Dress hats may be worn, but baseball caps and hats with print are not permitted. Also not permitted are jeans, T-shirts, shorts, jumpsuits or jumpers, attire with offensive language or images, or clothing other than the stated acceptable attire for Ladies and Gentlemen prom guests.

No exceptions regarding the dress code will be made. If you are unsure about the attire you plan to wear or have any questions about the dress code, feel free to [send an e-mail](#) to Homeschool Roster. All students attending the **Homeschool Prom 2020** are expected to adhere to the dress code.

## **IN/OUT PRIVILEGES**

The **Homeschool Prom 2020** is a closed event. For the safety of all, prom guests are expected to remain inside of the venue and designated areas during the hours of the prom. When you arrive, you will check in at the welcome table. Before entering the venue for the evening, be certain you have everything you will need (ex: camera, cell phone, inhaler, purse, etc.) to enjoy your evening. If a prom guest needs to go to their vehicle at any time with the intention of returning to the prom, they must be escorted by a prom chaperone. The prom guest will be required to check-out at the door and wait for a prom chaperone to escort them. When you are ready to leave for the evening, you will be required to check out at the welcome table. If you leave the designated prom area without a prom chaperone, you will not be allowed to return.

## **DANCE FORM**

Prom guests are expected to dance in good form with no provocative, sensual or vulgar behavior and/or expression. Public displays of affection, other than holding hands, are unacceptable. This includes, but is not limited to, sitting on laps, kissing, making out and inappropriate dancing.

## **CAUSE FOR EXPULSION**

No illegal drugs, alcohol, cigarettes or vaping products, or weapons (ex: guns, pocketknives, etc.) are allowed at the **Homeschool Prom 2020**. You will be asked to leave, without a refund, if you are found to be under the influence or in possession of any of the aforementioned items.

## **PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO**

There will be a roaming photographer at the prom. A themed "*Moonlight Masquerade*" backdrop will be available for prom guests to have (and take their own pictures) their picture taken. Encourage your teen to have that done. All pictures will be uploaded to an online location and available to everyone free of charge.

Only ticket holders will be allowed to enter the venue for picture taking. Parents/guardians without a ticket dropping off prom guests will not be allowed to enter the venue to take pictures.

Prom guests, parents/guardians and chaperones acknowledge pictures and video will be taken during the prom and may be used in the **Homeschool Roster - Get Out of the House, Homeschool Prom** and **Homeschool Roster** Facebook groups and page, and on the **Homeschool Roster** website and other for promotional purposes. Prom guests will have access to the photographs for memories and to share with family and friends.
