Code of Conduct

We have a wonderful evening planned for our homeschool teens at **Homeschool Prom 2019!** Our theme this year is "Once Upon a Time". Before purchasing a ticket to **Homeschool Prom 2019**, please read the following code of conduct. It provides information regarding our expectations of all prom students, guests of students and parents who will be joining us for the evening. The purchase of a ticket indicates you and your student have read, understand and agree to the details in the Code of Conduct. If you are purchasing a ticket for a student other than your own, be sure they have read, understand and agree to the details in the Code of Conduct.

STUDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS

Students and their guests at **Homeschool Prom 2019** include teenagers (ages 13 through high school). We are all examples for each other, so present yourself well and behave in a manner that represents the best you, at all times. Students and their guests are expected to follow the guidance of all chaperones.

DRESS CODE

Homeschool Prom 2019 is a formal dance, an evening for all guests to dress up in their finest attire.

Gentlemen may wear a tuxedo, suit or semi-formal dress pants with a buttoned-up shirt and a tie. An example is church clothes.

Ladies may wear a modest formal or semi-formal dress that is not revealing (i.e. no plunging neckline or back, no bare midriff and nothing see-through). Strapless and knee-length dresses may be worn. Keep modesty in mind; above the waist, not too revealing and below the waist, not too short.

Dress shoes are to be worn. If Converse are worn, they must be in good condition. Athletic shoes, flip flops and non-dressy boots (i.e. hiking, military, snow boots, etc.) are not permitted. Dress hats may be worn, but baseball caps and hats with offensive language (or images) are not permitted.

IN/OUT PRIVILEGES

Homeschool Prom 2019 is a closed event. For the safety of all, attendees are expected to remain inside of the venue and designated areas during the hours of the prom. When you arrive, you will check in at the welcome table. Before entering the venue for the evening, be certain you have everything you will need (ex: camera, cell phone, inhaler, purse, etc.) to enjoy your evening. If a student needs to go to their vehicle at any time with the intention of returning to the prom, they must be escorted by a chaperone. The student will be required to check-out at the door and wait for a chaperone to escort them. When you are ready to leave for the evening, you will be required to check out at the welcome table. If you leave the designated prom area without a chaperone, you will not be allowed to return.

DANCE FORM

Guests are expected to dance in good form with no provocative, sensual or vulgar behavior and/or expression.

CAUSE FOR EXPULSION

No illegal or prescription drugs, alcohol, cigarettes or vaping products, or weapons (ex: guns, pocket knives, etc.) are allowed at **Homeschool Prom 2019**. You will be asked to leave, without a refund, if you are found to be under the influence or in possession of any of the aforementioned items.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO

Students, their guests and parents/guardians acknowledge pictures and video will be taken during the prom and may be used in the **Homeschool Roster - Get Out of the House** and the **Homeschool Prom** closed Facebook groups, and on the **Homeschool Roster** website for future event promotion.

OUTSIDE FOOD

Food will be provided at **Homeschool Prom 2019**, so do not bring any outside food. Just come and enjoy the evening.
